Looking for a motif difficult in many beautiful gardens - Photo competition closes – jury awards seven entries – photos to be exhibited

Oldenburg – Even dream gardens can cause problems. “The lights must be just right and no people should be walking across the photo,” Dr. Hella Hahm, spokeswoman for CeWe Color, explains where the difficulties lay in the photo competition (organised by the management of the city administration of Oldenburg and by CeWe Color). Several hundred people nevertheless took part, and a jury chose twelve winning photos by seven photographers. The photos were distinguished by Hella Hahm and the manager of the Leffers clothing store, Sebo Kramer, in the Leffers Lichthof on Saturday. The winners received flowers and their photos printed on a 60 x 80 cm canvas. “The photos all turned out really well,” Sebo Kramer said. The winning photos, which are to be exhibited at Leffers, were taken by Jens Hotes, Petra Jacobs, Karin Klink, Manfred Schröder, Insa Worthmann, Ilse Heskamp and Aljoscha Gselmann.

Insa Wortmann was very successful with three photos and Aljoscha Gselmann had two winning photos. “We only bought our camera and year ago,” the couple explained. Karin Klink found it difficult to choose a motif: “So many beautiful gardens had been installed, so it wasn’t easy to choose one.”
